



Breath Test Operator Qualification CJSTC#851

The Intoxilyzer training program is designed to enhance public safety by ensuring the accuracy and scientific reliability of evidentiary breath and blood alcohol tests, facilitating enforcement of the implied consent laws under Florida State Chapter 11D-8, and promoting the qualifications and professionalism of persons responsible for breath and blood alcohol analysis within Florida.

The Breath Test Operator qualification course is a 16-hour training whereby students are approved to operate the Intoxilyzer equipment. Upon satisfactory completion of the course, certification will be conferred by the state of Florida. There is an attendance policy and those attending will be required to pass a written exam by a minimum of 80%.
