



## Concealed Carry Permit Class

This 4-hour class meets the requirements necessary for students to obtain their Florida Concealed Weapon/Firearm License. It consists primarily of classroom lecture that covers license protocols, general do's and don'ts, legal issues, use-of-force laws, basic firearm safety and a review of basic marksmanship. The class concludes with a live-fire exercise where students demonstrate safe shooting skills.

Students are provided with firearms, ammunition, targets, ear and eye protection, with certificates issued upon successful completion. Experienced instructors teach each class with multiple certifications (NRA, CJSTC, etc.).
