## **Off Duty Survival Tactics**

This two-day course will cover tactics needed to prepare the students for violent off-duty encounters. The decision to become involved in an off-duty incident should not be taken lightly based on the limited resources and lack of equipment off-duty officers generally have.

This course has a carefully structured blend of classroom, practical scenario training and live fire exercises.
