Patrol Knife Tactics

This 2-day (16 hour) course was developed specifically for law enforcement officers, and the primary purpose of this training is to educate officers on the tactical folder as a tool and as a weapon for defense.

The training will also cover the fundamentals necessary for surviving an edged weapon attack and for using a knife in a deadly force encounter to stop an immediate lethal threat when no other force options are available.

Course Topics Include:

- Knife Familiarization
- Legal Issues & Concerns
- Unarmed Response Tactics
- Ground Survival & Escape
- Emergency Wound Management
- Drawing & Deployment Tactics

- Folding duty knife (if they carry one)
- Duty belt and holster
