Single Officer Response to Active Threat and Shooter Incidents Instructor CJSTC#1403

While this course is designed with school resource officers as the main audience, the content in the course applies to any officer who is expected to respond as a single officer to an active threat or shooter incident. Therefore, this course can be adapted for law enforcement officers, no matter their role. This train the trainer course will teach student instructors the course so they can teach other instructors and members of their agency. This course involves a one-day live fire exercise.

Equipment: duty gear, vest, ear and eye protection.

Eligibility Requirements: Students must hold an active Criminal Justice High Liability Instructor Certification for **Firearms and General Instructor Certification.**
